Rehearsals

The rehearsal is usually scheduled for the day before the wedding and is normally a half hour in length.

Fees

Registered members: There is no fee for the use of the church if one of the parties is a registered member of our parish. However, the parish will happily accept any donation that the couple wishes to make to the parish.

Non-registered members: A \$100.00 deposit must be received 6 months prior to the wedding date towards the \$400.00 fee for use of the church. The \$300.00 balance must be received one month prior to the wedding date. The church and date are not officially reserved until the deposit is received.

Weddings for Non-Registered Couples

The couple must contact the parish office to reserve the date for their wedding.

The couple must also complete the required marriage preparation to marry in the Catholic Church. Under normal circumstances, the couple will complete the marriage preparation process at the home parish of either the Catholic groom or bride. As part of this preparation process, the couple must secure a letter of permission to marry outside of that parish from the pastor with whom they are engaging in marriage preparation. This marriage preparation process must begin no later than six months prior to the desired wedding date. Please note that the marriage cannot take place at St. Rose of Lima Parish, including at Our Lady of the Snows, until St. Rose of Lima Parish has received the proper documents from the marriage preparation process.

In special circumstances, and on a case-by-case basis, the couple may complete the marriage preparation process with either Fr. Ryan Amazeen or Deacon Stephen Noyes at St. Rose of Lima Parish.

Please keep in mind that if an annulment is required for either party, marriage preparation will not begin until the annulment is decreed.
